NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT / BRING A FRIEND TO DANCE PROGRAM

Dancemakers is still accepting new students for our 2009 / 2010 dance program. However, keep in mind, many of our classes are closed to new enrollment due to reaching maximum capacity, or are nearly closed with only 1, 2, or 3 spots remaining.

RECITAL COSTUMES

Recital costumes are ordered for students during the month of December to guarantee arrival for our annual recital in June.

This season we have offered installment payments to families with multiple students, students with multiple costumes, or families with significant financial hardship. Families selecting the installment option were required to notify the studio of their choice by October 1st, with their first installment payment due with tuition.

We apologize but we cannot accept any new installment notifications that were not made by the Oct 1st deadline.
